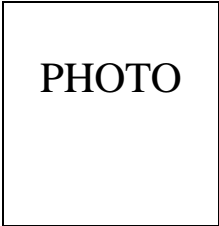

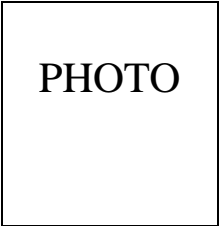

FACILITIES IN THE COLLEGE

Library

The college has a well-equipped library consisting of more than 4511 volumes of books, on different branches of knowledge in a spacious area of 2800 sq.ft. There are 46 journals, magazines and weeklies which enhance the knowledge of students and keep them abreast of the latest developments. Falling in line with the latest trends, the library has been computerized, which facilitates easy access to books. Browsing is provided for the students in the library.

Teaching Aids

The Classrooms are fitted with LCD Projector, TV, OHP facilities and Audio system.

Counselling Cell

Each student is assigned a staff Counsellor / Institutional Guardian who will provide guidance and help and advice the student personally throughout the duration of the course. Students having serious problems are counselled by trained therapists.

CDE Programmes

Each Department organizes Seminars, Lectures and hands on courses by Renowned Faculty in order to expose students to different viewpoints. These CDE Programmes are accredited by The Tamil Nadu Dental Council.

Cultural and Sports activities

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. LEAVE RULES

Application for leave must be submitted in advance in the prescribed format, signed by the HOD before being approved by the Principal.

Any leave availed without prior permission should be justified by proper proof such as medical certificate and leave letter from parents.

2. BEHAVIOUR

- a. Students should attend the college in uniform along with their identity cards and name badges.
- b. Students are expected to be punctual to class.
- c. For any function, conference or meeting, students should get prior permission from the Principal / Director.
- d. They are advised to be polite to elders and courteous to all.
- e. Writing anything on the walls, desk or any property in college premises is strictly forbidden.
- f. Students should park their vehicles in the space meant for parking.
- g. Use of mobile phones is not permitted during college hours and will be confiscated.
- h. Students should not highlight, underline, write or remove pages from the library books.
- i. Students are responsible for their belongings. The college will not be responsible for any loss of property.
- j. Smoking as well as consumption of any intoxicants is strictly prohibited inside the campus.

k. Dress Code:

Girls: Should be dressed in Chudidars only with hair combed neatly. (Scarf if any to be tucked inside the apron).

Boys: Should be dressed in shirts, trousers and leather shoes. They should be well groomed with short hair and clean shave.

Students should compulsorily come in respective **uniforms** and wear apron in the clinics.

3. ATTENDANCE AND PERFORMANCE

Being a professional college, students are expected to attend all the theory / practical classes as well as clinics. However a minimum attendance stipulated by university (at present 85%) in each department is mandatory for appearing in the University examinations. **Students who have failed in any subject will be allowed to appear for the next university examination only after fulfilling the mandatory attendance. Similarly only those students, will be allowed to attend university exams, who have completed their quota of work.**

4. INTERNAL ASSESSMENT EXAMINATIONS

Three Internal assessment examinations are being conducted regularly for the students. **It is compulsory to attend all the Three Assessments including the model exam.** The absentees will be marked Zero and average of Three Internal Assessment marks will be calculated.

5. IDENTITY CARDS

Students should have their identity cards with them which is duly signed by the Principal. The cards will be issued to them immediately after admission to the college.

6. LIBRARY

- a. The Library will be kept open on all working days from 8.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m.
- b. Strict silence should be maintained in and around library
- c. Students are issued a card that will borrow him/her one book.
- d. The book should be returned on / before the due date. If the student fails to return the book on time, he / she will have to pay fine Rs.5/- for each day of delay.
- e. Magazines, Dailies, booklets and references should not be taken out from the library.
- f. If a student happens to lose any book, he/she should pay the current price of the book and a fine decided by the principal

7. COLLEGE PROPERTY AND EQUIPMENT

Students are expected to take proper care of the college property and to keep the premises neat and tidy. Any damage done to the property of the college by disfiguring walls, doors, fittings, breaking furniture etc., is a breach of discipline. The students found responsible will be charged for the loss or damage.

8. MEETING OF PARENTS WITH PRINCIPAL / HOD

Parents / Guardians are requested to meet the Principal / Head of the Department periodically to know about their ward's progress in their studies and behaviour.

9. UNIVERSITY EXAMINATION

February 1st/ August 1st every year.

If the date of commencement falls on Saturdays, Sundays or declared public holidays, the examination shall begin on the next working day.

10. FEES PAYMENT

As per the instructions of the Government, the annual fee should be drawn through a Demand Draft in favour of Sri Ramakrishna Dental College & Hospital, Coimbatore.

PROHIBITION OF RAGGING

Government of Tamilnadu has issued very strict instructions regarding ragging. Any students found or reported to have indulged in/encouraging ragging will be dismissed from the college and legally steps will be taken as per **Tamilnadu Government gazette extraordinary act No.7 of 1997** and as per the order of the Honourable Supreme Court of India. The Ragging incident will also be reported to the university.

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has given a more comprehensive meaning of ragging as under;

“Ragging is any disorderly conduct, whether by words spoken or written, or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any student, indulging in rowdy or indiscipline activities which causes or are likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or junior students and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the psychic of a fresher or a junior student”.

The students found to be involved in ragging will be suspended or may be handedover to the police. They may be dismissed from the college if found guilty in the enquiry conducted.

The students are advised not to involve themselves in any of the activities based on politics, caste and community.

The students are advised to desist from indulging themselves in bad and unlawful activities, which may bring a bad name not only to themselves but also to the institution and organization. The students who are found to violate the rules and regulations laid down by the college organization are liable for punishment including suspension or dismissal from the college.

“If any incidents of ragging come to the notice of the authority, the concerned students shall be given liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him from the institution.”

HOSTEL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Inmates should abide by the following rules and regulations of the hostel.

1. Students will not be permitted to leave the hostel before 6.00 a.m. and they should report before
7.00 p.m. – Ladies Hostel
8.30 p.m. – Boys Hostel
Strict action will be taken towards anyone reporting late.
2. Smoking, drinking, gambling, drug abuse is strictly prohibited inside the college.
3. No day-scholars should be entertained in the hostel by the inmate at any time.
4. Hostel rooms must be maintained clean.
5. In case of sickness with / without absence from the classes report immediately to the principal and the chief warden.
6. Use electricity judiciously.
7. Hostel authorities are not responsible for any loss of personal belongings.
8. Every student must maintain an entry in outgoing register.
9. Students can leave the hostel only with the prior permission from warden with relevant letter for going home.
10. From time to time, there may be inspection of the hostel by the principal / committee members which has to be honoured by the inmates.
11. In case of any grievance or dissatisfaction with the service of the servants, the inmates should bring this matter to the notice of the supervisor. Under no circumstances, the student should deal the matter directly with the servants.
12. The visitors can meet the inmates only as per the following schedule.

On working days	:	4.00 P.M. to 6.30 P.M.
On Sundays and Holidays	:	8.00 A.M. to 6.30 P.M.

13. Every student should make an entry in the outgoing register before going out. At the time of going home, the inmates should get the gate pass signed by the Supervisor / warden and they should also make an entry in the home going register.
14. Visitors are allowed to meet the inmates only in the veranda and on no one account they can be taken to any rooms of the inmates. Only the parents or the persons authorized by the parents will be permitted to meet the inmates.
15. The inmates should pay their mess bills before 15th of every month. A fine of Rs. 50/- will be collected till 25th of the month, after which the inmate will not be allowed to take food in the hostel.
16. If the inmate overstays leave more than days intimated earlier, he/she should produce a letter from parents explaining the cause of the extended leave.
17. Students can leave the hostel only with prior permission from warden with the relevant permission letter, while going to their home.
18. Students should intimate to the warden as soon as they arrive from their homes with the re-joining letter duly signed by the parents without which they will not be allowed into the hostel.
