### Alumni Feedback on Curriculum & Syllabus-2020-2021

Date: 26.03.2022 No of respondents: 84

### REPORT

- 55% of the students responded that they have gained excellent knowledge and skills to manage common dental health problems while 43% felt that their knowledge and skills were good.
- 2. 56% respondents felt confident that they would be able to apply the principles of ethics and legal requirements in the practice of dentistry while 39% felt fairly capable.
- 3. 66% of the graduates were very confident to refer patients for specialized treatment while 32% had a fair amount of confidence to do so.
- 4. 54% professionals had clear cut knowledge to understand, comprehend and interpret data like radiographs while 38% had above average knowledge.
- 55% of the candidates had outstanding skills to use contemporary technology for documentation and record maintenance while 41% had good technological skills.
- 6. 45% felt that they had equipped themselves well with the basic principles of practice administration, financial and personnel management of a dental practice while 43% opined that their skills were fair
- 7. 60% of the students had excellent knowledge about the appropriate methods of waste disposal and infection control whereas 37% felt that their knowledge was good.
- 8. 57% of the candidates were very confident in their ability to evaluate and implement preventive programs at individual and community level whereas 36% were confident to do so.
- 9. 57% of respondents had top-notch ability to obtain methodical patient history through thorough clinical examination and arrive at a provisional differential and final diagnosis while 38% had good ability for this
- 10. 58% had superior skills to carryout appropriate investigations pertaining to the patient & dental condition whereas 36% had good skills
- 11. 46% opined that they had very good knowledge of the latest trends and technologies in providing dental care while another 46% had good knowledge
- 12. 66% of the graduates felt they had superlative confidence in their basic skills to deliver quality dental care whereas 32% had good confidence
- 13. 43% of the participants perceived that they were excellent enough to recognize and manage medical emergencies wherein 44% felt they were good

14. 64% were highly satisfied with the comprehensive dental training in this college while 25% were satisfied

15. 52% of the graduates were highly interested in attending continuing training in this college whereas 33% had a fair amount of interest

16. The major training programs of interest were endodontics, aesthetics, surgical procedures and implantology

### Recommendations

From the above feedback it is evident that 55% to 66% of the students were confident with the following attributes needed for a qualifying dental student.

Knowledge and skills to manage common dental health problems, knowledge about Ethics and legal requirements, Investigation and interpretation of radiographs, Recording history, Documentation & record maintenance, Waste disposal and infection control, Preventive programs at individual and community level while only 45% were confident in Practice administration, financial and personnel management of a dental practice, Management of medical emergencies, and knowledge about Latest trends and technologies

IQAC recommends training programs in the above in addition to the routine work & procedures done.

### Professionals' Feedback on Curriculum & Syllabus-2020-2021

Date: 11.03.2021 - Number of respondents: 22

### REPORT

- 1. 80% of the professionals answered that the current curriculum and Syllabus prepares students for present and future challenges and twenty percentage had negative response.
- 2. 80% of the professionals agreed that the examination pattern was relevant to the current scenario and twenty percentage had not agreed.
- 3. 76% of the examiners opined that the examination was conducted in accordance with university protocol pattern while the remaining 24% felt some deviation in the protocol.
- 4. Some of the other suggestions were
- a) Need more specimens and Embryology models.
- b) Since CNS & Special senses portions as per curriculum is limited for dental students. Guyton cannot be the Standard, Preferably A.K.Jain (dental), Chaudhary (dental) or Indhu Khurana can be kept as standard. Guyton can be used as Reference
- c) Forensic Odontology can be included as a separate department and it can be introduced as a spate subject to students too.
- d) Self-illustrated Microscope to provide Clinical pathology exposure for student
- e) Need clinical exposure from II year itself.
- f) More clinical case & latest treatment exposure in general medicine cases is needed.
- g) More exposure to clinical work.

h) Students might be given some more attention for revision of the chapters before exam.



### REPORT

The mission of Sri Ramakrishna Dental College and Hospital is "to develop a learner centred educational environment". Therefore, the College Curriculum committee recommended obtaining a faculty feedback to assess the effectiveness of teaching-learning process in imparting employability skills and problem solving ability. Suggestions for the same were requested. Department-specific topics that require additional attention and creative teaching strategies were sought for. Workshop/CDE programs/ Seminar for curriculum enrichment/ Knowledge and skill enhancement program organized by college was asked

In March 2022, Google forms were used to collect feedback from the all the teaching faculty in accordance with the aforementioned proposals. 84 faculties provided their opinions.

82% of the faculties responded that the teaching learning process is aligned with modern practice requirements and the students have adequate employability skills. 96% of faculties think that the teaching imparted develops fair diagnostic acumen, critical thinking and problem solving ability in students.

Suggestions given by the rest include exposure to modern equipments and techniques, and conducting Value added programs, hands on training, self directed learning and workshops

### Recommendations:

To enhance the current teaching practices, it is recommended to analyze and implement the suggestions given by the faculty - Workshop on teaching learning methodology, E-content development and photography. To conduct more value added and add o programs & provide hands on training







Students Feedback on Curriculum & Syllabus -2020-2021

Date: 16th April 2022 - No Of Students: 478

### REPORT

The mission of Sri Ramakrishna Dental College and Hospital is "to develop a learner centred educational environment". Therefore, the College Curriculum committee recommended obtaining a student feedback to assess the effectiveness of teaching-learning process in imparting employability skills and problem solving ability. The adequacy of the teaching learning material including E-Learning Portal and library and innovative teaching methods were assessed. As per the above recommendations it was decided to acquire the feedback of all the students (I BDS to CRRI) on 16, 04, 2022.

A total number of 478 students gave their valuable feedback by answering a questionnaire sent as a Google form.

96% of students agreed that the course fully covered the syllabus and made use of audiovisual tools such projectors, power point presentations, and clinical case videos. 95% believed the clinical scenarios, problem based and analytical reasoning used by the faculty improved their diagnostic and clinical acumen and made them competent clinicians.

12% of students are not satisfied with the E-learning portal provided by the college while 8% of the students have asked for more learning material in the library and teaching methods aligned with modern day practice.

### Recommendations:

IQAC recommends introducing new E-learning portal & programs aimed at latest techniques practiced in dentistry.
