
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Feedback of Stakeholders (2021-22) & action recommended report - 2022-23

1.	Advanced treatments like Implants, FPD Digital Dentistry	Undergraduate level implant program should be initiated by the implant dentistry department. To define objectives, training methodologies and outcome.
2.	Refresher course for NEET for CRIs	Students interested to be enrolled and every day 8:00 – 9:00 classes for the same can be conducted with monthly once evaluation tests.
3.	Practical training to handle medical emergencies encountered in dental practice.	OMFS department to initiate and document the ICU and ER postings and conduct evaluation programs through OSCE / simulation
