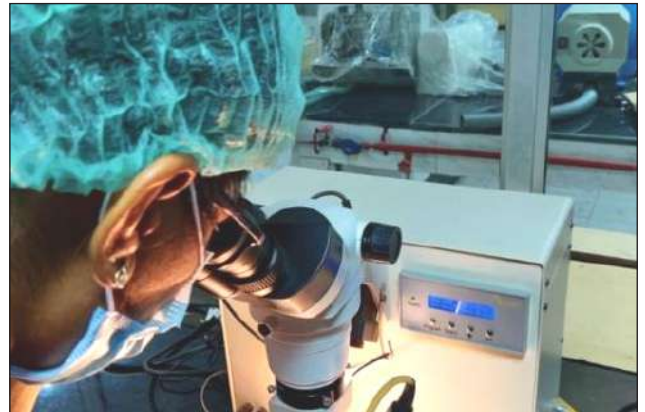
INFRASTRUCTURE Academic clinic

Sri Ramakrishna Dental College boasts the Academic clinic in which both undergraduates and postgraduates attend the outpatients. In this clinic the graduates acquire skills of dentistry by treating a few thousand patients every year. The Academic clinic is equipped with 260 dental chairs, Digital X-ray units and other advanced equipment's in dentistry for enhancing the learning process of students and shaping them into better professionals. This year clinical system was introduced from the month of June.



Central Lab

Our Central lab is well equipped with equipment's like induction casting machine, ceramic furnace, milling machine, High speed spindle grinder and Bego Surveyor. We train our post graduate students with metal ceramic and All ceramic restorations, precision attachments, Cast Partial Denture, Maxillofacial Prosthesis, Implant supported restorations so that they get to know the step by step laboratory procedures which will help them to bring perfection in their clinical work.



Classroom

Sri Ramakrishna dental college has been consistent to maintain excellence in the academic standards since its inception. The college has 4 adequately spaced lecture halls. Each lecture Hall has the capacity to accommodate 100 students. The lecture halls have a raised dais and are equipped with Smart Boards which enlightens the students learning experience.



Conference Hall

Sri Ramakrishna Dental College and Hospital has a fully air conditioned conference Hall. The conference hall has a stadium type of seating which can accommodate 250 individuals. The raised dias and podium along with the digital projector and Audio system equips the Hall. The scientific, cultural events and various committee meetings are held in the Hall regularly.



Auditorium

Sri Ramakrishna Dental College and Hospital has a 1100 seat auditorium. Graduation day program and cultural program are held in the auditorium.



CSSD

Central Sterile Services Department (CSSD) is an integrated place in our dental hospital where dental/ surgical supplies and equipment are sterilized so that they are ready for use in patient care.



ICT (Information and communication Technology)

Sri Ramakrishna Dental College and hospital has its own ICT wing functioning within the campus. The ICT Facilities of the college include Learning Management Software, Library Management Software, Store Management software and Patient Management Software.



Seminar Halls

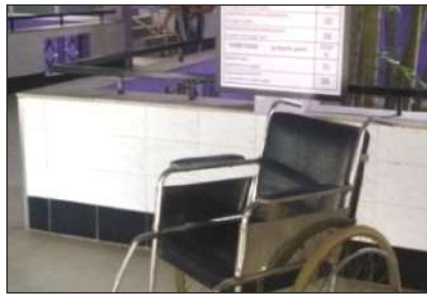
Greenery

Dental Patient Management Software (DMS)

DMS is the most comprehensive and integrated system for complete maintenance of outpatient record. It makes clinical notes and documentation legible and reduces clinical errors. It maintains the day to day appointments of the patients. The investigations, Treatment plan and Referral made easy in this system. It also holds the ease of billing for dental treatment procedure.

Library Management System (LMS)

It is a well-chosen system which gives access and manages the resources in library. It increases the library's efficiency by saving valuable administration time which lead to a better educational experience for pupils and helps to develop independent learning. It gives access for registration of books with accession number in both department and central library and maintains the issuance and collection of books including fine for delayed returning of books.

Store Management - Wellspring

Store management system automates goods procurement process, receipt of goods, PO creation, Indent creation, approval from higher authority, stock book entry, bill passing, issue of material for departments, expired goods, purchase and sales return, stock book maintenance. It generates various store reports.

DEPARTMENT PROFILE

ORAL MEDICINE& RADIOLOGY

The specialty is involved in the clinical and radiographic diagnosis, treatment planning, and medical management of a wide spectrum of cases such as odontogenic & non-odontogenic cysts and tumors, mucosal lesions, temporomandibular joint disorders, salivary gland diseases and lesions and fractures of the oro-facial region. Our students are taught to examine the oral cavity, recognize the range of normal appearances, and distinguish what is abnormal by studying the features of various oral diseases. We provide adequate knowledge to the students about common laboratory investigations and interpretation of their results, medical complications that can arise while treating systemically compromised patients, and take prior precautions/ consent from the concerned medical specialist. The students are trained such that they gain the competency to take intra-oral radiographs and interpret the radiographic findings. They are also made aware of the importance of intra- and extra-oral radiographs in forensic identification and age estimation.

To accomplish this, we are equipped with state-of-the-art digital intra-oral and extra-oral X-ray units with adequate training being imparted on radiation safety and protection. Our radiology department meets the requirements of the ATOMIC ENERGY REGULATORY BOARD. We also ensure that the students are familiar with jurisprudence, ethics and understand the significance of dental records with respect to law.

ORAL & MAXILLOFACIAL SURGERY

Oral and maxillofacial surgery is a branch of surgery to correct a wide spectrum of diseases, injuries and defects in the head, neck, face, jaws and the hard and soft tissues of the oral and maxillofacial region. It is a recognized international surgical specialty and it is one of the nine specialties of dentistry. The Maxillofacial post graduate out-patient department deals with minor oral surgical procedures like Impactions, Trauma, Surgical removal of cysts and Oral Implantology. The Maxillofacial unit teams up with surgeons of other specialties like Neurosurgery, Plastic Surgery, Surgical Oncology and undertake Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgeries, Management of Trauma patients, Orthognathic Surgeries and Oncosurgical cases. Post graduate programme was started by 2009. There are 6 post graduate students in the department who are posted on-call 24×7 at the hospital casualty. They undergo special training in departments like Casualty, Anesthesia, and Intensive care, General Medicine, General Surgery, Neurosurgery, Ophthalmology, ENT, Radiology, Orthopedic, Plastic Surgery and Surgical Oncology at Sri Ramakrishna Hospital.

Clinical Core

- Dentoalveolar surgery (surgery to remove impacted teeth, difficult tooth extractions, extractions on medically compromised patients, bone grafting or pre prosthetic surgery to provide better anatomy for the placement of implants, dentures, or other dental prostheses)
- Diagnosis and Surgical treatment of benign and malignant pathology, cysts, tumors etc.

- Diagnosis and Surgical treatment of congenital craniofacial malformations such as cleft lip and palate and cranial vault malformations such as craniosynostosis, (craniofacial surgery).
- Diagnosis and Surgical treatment of soft and hard tissue trauma of the oral and maxillofacial region (jaw fractures, cheek bone fractures, nasal fractures, Face bone fractures, skull fractures and eye socket fractures).
- Diagnosis and treatment of chronic facial pain disorders.
- Diagnosis and treatment of temporomandibular joint (TMJ) disorders.
- Cosmetic surgery limited to the head and neck: orthognathic surgeries and allied surgeries (rhytidectomy/facelift, browlift/blepharoplasty, otoplasty, rhinoplasty, septoplasty, cheek augmentation, chin augmentation, genioplasty, neck liposuction, lip enhancement, injectable cosmetic treatments, botox, chemical peel etc.)Oncological(oral cancer) surgeries and reconstruction of defects.

ORTHODONTICS & DENTOFACIAL ORTHOPAEDICS

The Department was initiated for Under-graduate students in the year 2000 and post graduate students in the year 2009. Undergraduate students during their clinical posting students learn to diagnose and identify various malocclusion of the orofacial skeleton, preventive, interceptive and corrective aspects of treating skeletal and dental malocclusions and fabricate various removable appliances for correction of minor

orthodontic deformities. Department is employed with highly qualified faculties with super specialty degrees like MOrth RCPS to guide the students for the endeavors. Every post graduate student get to work with different forms of treatment like ceramic appliances, self-ligating like Damon, lingual appliances, clear aligners like Invisalign, orthognathic surgeries and orthopedic cases, along with special cases like cleft lip and palate, multi-disciplinary cases and syndromic cases. The undergraduate students will be awarded with the prestigious Dr. Rangachari Gold medal by the institution, every year for their excellence in the field of Orthodontics.

Department has separate fully equipped UG and PG clinics to cater the needs of the students' education and patient work. We have the latest state of the art digital software, like Dolphin for cephalometric analysis and documentation. Digital surgical planning, facial morphing, treatment simulations for advanced clinical knowledge and improved patient education is being done in the department. The ultimate aim of the department is to provide the patient with an exquisite smile. Apart from college central library, the department library has various National and International Journal articles till latest edition and more than 50 books. The department is equipped with an exclusive photography room with tripods and rectangle soft boxes for improved photography experience and documentation.

PERIODONTICS

Periodontology is the science dealing with the health and diseases of the investing and supporting structures of the teeth and oral mucous membrane. It also deals with early intervention of gingival and periodontal diseases. It is a branch which exclusively deals with periodontal regeneration and gingival augmentation procedures, thereby increasing the periodontal support as well as increase in width and thickness of gingiva. The ultimate motto of the department is that every candidate must achieve a high degree of clinical proficiency in the subject matter and develop competence in research and its methodology as related to the field concerned. Post Graduate students are allowed to do basic and advanced surgical procedures as well as research work under the able guidance of our experienced faculties. The objective of PG course is to train a candidate so as to ensure higher competence in both general and special area of interest and prepare him for a career in teaching, research and specialty practice.

Under graduate students are trained by exposing them to basic procedures such as case history taking, scaling, root planing and simple minor periodontal surgeries such as gingivectomy, gingivoplasty. The department has fully equipped electrically operated chairs along with ultrasonic scalers available separately for UG students, PG students and faculty. The department has an implant clinic equipped with an electrically operated chair along with physiodispenser, implant systems with implant placement kit, RVG and compatible x-ray. Adequately equipped with advanced diagnostic instruments and equipments needed for advanced periodontal regeneration techniques and root coverage procedures. The department has state of art soft tissue lasers and electrosurgical cautery to perform advanced surgical procedures. The students are regularly performing biochemical assays in oral fluids and surgical procedures as a part of research work.

PEDIATRIC & PREVENTIVE DENTISTRY

It is a distinct branch of dentistry which deals with treating children from infancy through adolescence including those with special health care needs. A Child handled well, in a dental setting, would develop a positive attitude towards dentistry. Pediatric Dentistry goes a long way not only in instilling positive attitude in children but also in changing the perspective of the society towards dentistry.

Children may not speak but they may bite, they may not tell but may cry". Managing children is easily said than done. The adage "If milk teeth go sour, permanent teeth will go foul stresses the importance of Pediatric Dentistry. The vision of the Department includes Teaching, Service and Research. The teaching program is designed to provide the dental students with exemplary experience in managing the dental care needs of children. Staff and students develop a friendly rapport with the child and we believe in Win the child and make wonders happen. The department provides a child friendly environment with a spacious waiting parlour and an attractive aquarium. Pediatric dental chairs, cartoon studded clinical area, fascinating toys and winsome gifts make the children spell bounded. It is equipped with advanced equipment's and instruments like rotary handpiece, apex locator, pulp tester, thermo plasticised GP unit, conventional radiography, RVG and intra oral camera. A separate pre-clinical lab, a top-quality sterilization room and a discussion room for the UGs are available. The Department library houses numerous books of national and international authors and various journals to enrich the knowledge in paediatric dentistry.

CONSERVATIVE DENTISTRY & ENDODONTICS

The Department is primarily concerned with the preservation and restoration of diseased teeth back to their form, function and aesthetics. It has both Under Graduate & Post Graduate programs, wherein students are trained in academics, research and patient management. The primary goal is to relieve pain, and enhance the smile and facial aesthetics of our patients with state-of-the-art equipment and contemporary techniques. The department has fully equipped, clinical sections for undergraduate and postgraduate students wherein all advanced treatment modalities are provided. A phantom-head laboratory with simulators resembling oral cavity for appropriate hands – on student training prior to clinical exposure is also on deck.

The postgraduate section has all modern equipment like Digital radiography using RVG and PSP systems, Dental Operating Microscope, Micro surgical instruments, LASERS, Instrument retrieval kits, Loupes, Endosonics, Air abrasion kit, LED light curing units, Thermoplastic obturating systems. It also has a well-equipped isolated operator for microsurgical and micro endodontic procedures. A fully installed casting and ceramic lab with all equipment for doing specialized laboratory work helps postgraduate students to deliver comprehensive treatment to satisfy the patient needs. The Department Library is stocked with journals and books by National and International authors for ready reference and updating of knowledge.

ORAL PATHOLOGY & MICROBIOLOGY

Oral pathology is a confluence of basic and clinical dentistry. It is a building block of dentistry. It is a branch of dentistry which is involved in the study of basic oral and dental tissues, and also about its disease and abnormalities. The department was started in the year 2000 at the time of inception of the college. This department teaches and coaches two exam going subjects per year. From 2008 to till date, as per the new regulations of DCI Oral Histology & Dental Anatomy is taught in the first year BDS and Oral Pathology in second & third year BDS.

Apart from academic teaching the department also undertakes the responsibility of clinical histopathology. Biopsy specimens are received from various departments of the institution as well as referrals from other hospitals both in and outside the region. The biopsy tissue both hard and soft specimens are processed in the histopathology lab and diagnostic reports are provided. The department boasts of well qualified and well trained staffs and technicians who takes care of teaching as well as clinical and histopathological work. The department is well equipped with semi-automatic microtome and research microscope with projection system.

This subject gives the knowledge about the basis of public health, preventive dentistry, public health problems in India, Nutrition, Environment and their role in health, basics of dental statistics, epidemiological methods, National oral health policy with emphasis on oral health policy.

Department of Public Health Dentistry has been at the center of the efforts by Sri Ramakrishna Dental College & Hospital, Coimbatore in oral healthcare to reach the unreached population. We endeavor to deliver dental treatment to the community through organized dental health camps especially in rural areas and for the dentally indigent. The subject integrates topics like minimal invasive dentistry, evidence based research, fluorides, indices, epidemiology with special emphasis oral health delivery. We are pioneers in conducting dental outreach activities and field experiences for dental students. The department is at the forefront in enthusiastically participating in various health activities in the region and provides oral health under the school oral health program for the schools in Coimbatore region. The department aims to impart students; the skills of identifying health problems affecting the society, conducting health surveys, conducting health education classes and deciding health strategies. The department helps to inculcate a positive attitude towards the problems of the society.

Comprehensive Dental Clinic

The department has established a comprehensive dental clinic from November 2020 in the dental college that provides single point multispecialty treatment and care for the patients. The clinic is handled by experienced dentist providing a holistic treatment for the various dental problems.

Tobacco Control & Cessation Center

The Tobacco Cessation Centre is a special service run by the department in order to aid persons wishing to quit smoking or chewing tobacco and tobacco containing products. The centre is operational on all days from Monday to Friday. The patients undergo a detailed evaluation and are counseled regarding appropriate strategies to aid quitting. Carbon Monoxide monitor to assess the effects on smoking on lungs is available in the Tobacco Control & Cessation Centre.

Prosthodontics is a branch of dentistry which deals with treating children, and adults including geriatrics with special health care needs. Any patient handled with care, during dental procedure, would develop a positive attitude towards treatment. The department offers undergraduate and postgraduate training for the restoration and replacement of missing teeth. The department offers care to patients who have significant damage to existing teeth, missing teeth, congenital orofacial defects and restores the dentition to form, function, and aesthetics. "DeVan's golden statement, "Perpetual preservation of what remains is more important than the meticulous replacement of what is missing," still rings true.

"Dr. M. M. Devan – Should meet the mind of the patient before we meet the mouth of the patient". The vision of the Department is to train the students to be competent in clinical abilities including prevention and post care in prosthodontics, and research activities. In our teaching schedule we provide our students with clinical skills, theoretical knowledge, communicative skills and geriatric care needs of adults. The Department provides a homely environment with a spacious waiting area and an attractive clinical space. The Department is equipped with an advanced implant clinic and equipments like Induction casting machine, ceramic furnace, digital milling machine, RVG and intra oral camera and Fibre optic and LED handpieces. A well equipped pre-clinical lab for undergraduate and a phantom lab, and a separate ceramic lab for both undergraduate and postgraduate students is available. DEPARTMENT OF ANATOMY

Students gain knowledge and insight into the functional anatomy of the normal human head and neck, functional histology and an appreciation of the genetic basis of inheritance and disease, and the embryological development of clinically important structures, so that relevant anatomical & scientific foundations are laid down for the clinical years of the BDS course.

Human anatomy forms the foundation of clinical practice, diagnostic radiology, emergency medicine and surgery. Hence, special care is taken towards training students in the applied aspects of anatomy. The department aims to instill excellent knowledge of anatomy, as relevant to dental students. All branches of anatomy are taught using various teaching modalities, including the latest 3D anatomy software installed in the lecture halls. Gross anatomy knowledge is enriched by dissection and demonstration of dissected specimens in the dissection hall. Histology, embryology and genetics are taught with emphasis on the functional and clinical importance. The practical labs are also the places where students are first sensitised to the core

values of professionalism and ethics. Use of the learning management system in teaching-learning and integration of e-content in learning allows our students to access necessary learning material and guidance at their own pace.



DEPARTMENT OF PHYSIOLOGY

Human physiology seeks to understand the mechanisms that work to keep the human body alive and functioning, through scientific enquiry into the nature of mechanical, physical and biochemical functions of humans, their organs, and the cells of which they are composed. The principal level of focus of physiology is at the level of organs and systems within systems.

Physiology is a basic medical science taught to the health care students which explains about the functions of each system and how they coordinate to maintain good health. The broad goal of the teaching undergraduate students in Human Physiology aims at providing the student comprehensive knowledge of the normal functions of the organ systems of the body to facilitate an understanding of the physiological basis of health and disease.



Biochemistry deals with chemistry of life in living organisms. Students in dentistry learn the basic concepts in this basic science specialty. The major aim is to provide a sound but crisp knowledge on the biochemical basis of the life processes relevant to the human system and to dental/medical practice. They are practically trained in clinical biochemistry and biochemical techniques which enhance their minds in research that will help the next generation health professionals to serve humanity with dedication.

Our department discover, develop and disseminate knowledge in biochemistry for emerging dentists, to inculcate education to the students that provides a strong foundation and curative skills in the rapidly advancing fields of biochemistry which is essential for dentistry and to provide a conducive learning environment of creative thinking that enables dental students to serve the nation in promotive, preventive and rehabilitative aspects of health care. We encourage students to pursue research work related to biochemistry in dentistry.

DEPARTMENT OF MICROBIOLOGY

“Without Laboratories Men of Science are Soldiers without Arms” We explain the pathogenicity & lab diagnosis of various microbial infections and to apply the knowledge of sterilization & disinfection in clinical practice. Categorize and plan collection & transport of clinical specimen to the laboratory and prioritise the prevention of hospital acquired infections. The crisis on increasing antibiotic resistance recommends the knowledge on judicious drug usage to prevent drug resistance. The awareness of Immunity, vaccination and its responses, towards an infectious disease helps in infection control.

Medical Microbiology is a large subset of microbiology, is a branch of medical science concerned with the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of infectious diseases. We introduce the students to the exciting world of microbes and to make the students aware of various branches of microbiology, significance and contribution of each branch to mankind and other fields of medicine. Our vision is to be a leading department of infectious diseases research in relation to dentistry. The mission includes providing quality education in microbiology related to dentistry & inculcating good ethics in diagnosis & treatment. To encourage students to achieve proficiency, to pursue research activities related to emerging & re-emerging microbial infections. The department activities include training the students both in theory, practical classes, research activities and to develop the skill and knowledge on applied and oral microbiology with aseptic precautions.

DEPARTMENT OF PATHOLOGY

DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL MEDICINE

General medicine is one of the very important branches of clinical practice and is taught at BDS III year level. It is dealing with the prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of disease especially in adult population. The intention of the department focuses on providing preventive, curative and rehabilitative measures.

The department is conducting classes to undergraduate students with clinical demonstration class, lecture class & seminars. Students are taught in such a manner that he/she is able to record the arterial pulse, blood pressure and be capable of suspecting by sight and superficial examination of body, diseases of the heart, lung, kidneys, blood etc. Special training will be provided to make the student capable of handling medical emergencies encountered in dental practice. Sri Ramakrishna dental college is attached with Sri Ramakrishna multi-speciality hospital for giving live demo on patients to III BDS students.

DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SURGERY

General surgery is the branch of medicine that deals with the physical manipulation of a bodily structure to diagnose, prevent, or cure an ailment. The department of general surgery is undertaking extensive teaching and training for III BDS students through lectures, clinics, seminars, case presentation and learning operative skills in operation theatre.

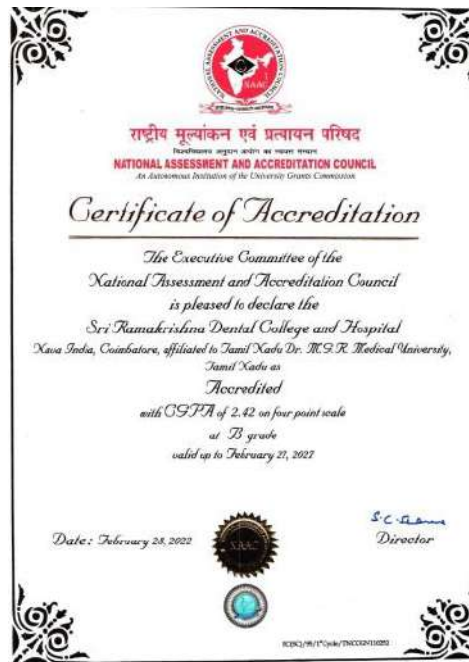

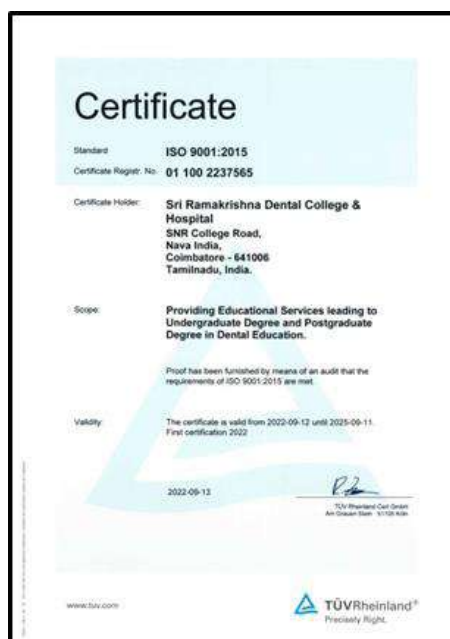
National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC)

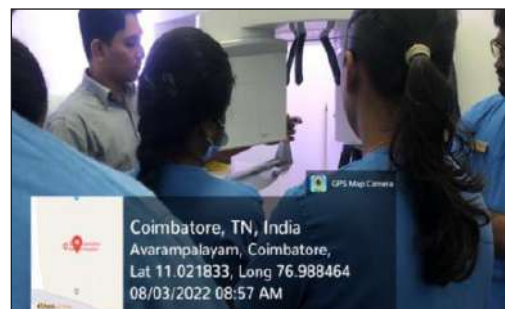
Water Plant Visit

VALUE ADDED PROGRAMS

Rotary Endodontics

Department of Conservative Dentistry & Endodontics organized a 3 day "Workshop and Hands-on program on Rotary Endodontics" from 14-2-22 to 16-2-22. The participants were introduced to the concept of rotary Endodontics through interactive lectures, live demonstrations and hands on training on both acrylic blocks and extracted natural teeth. On the final day of the program, the participants independently performed root canal therapy under rubber dam isolation with rotary endodontic instruments under the strict individual supervision and guidance of the faculties. 6 interns participated in the program.



Full Mouth Rehabilitation Clinical Treatment Prospective

The Department of Prosthodontics conducted a workshop on "Full mouth rehabilitation Clinical treatment prospective" on 27.8.2022 by Prof. (Dr.) Chetan Hegde, Professor and Head of the Department of Prosthodontics, AB Shetty Memorial Institute of Dental Sciences, Mangalore. The program was beneficial to the PG students, private practitioners and faculties as several clinical situations were explained. 46 participants benefited from this program.



The Art of Esthetic Restoration With Composites

The department of Conservative Dentistry & Endodontics organised a hands on course on "The Art Of Esthetic Restoration With Composites" on 11th, 13th & 14th of September. 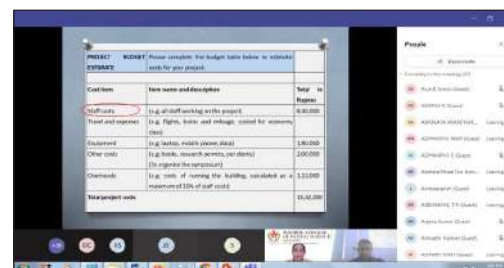
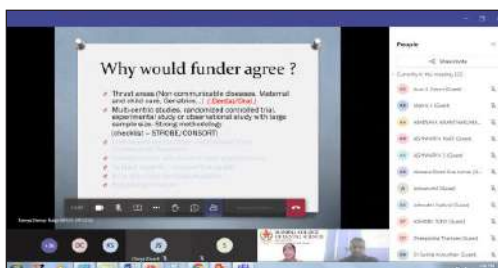
Skill Development Refresher Programme On Individually Trained Oral Prophylaxis (Itop)

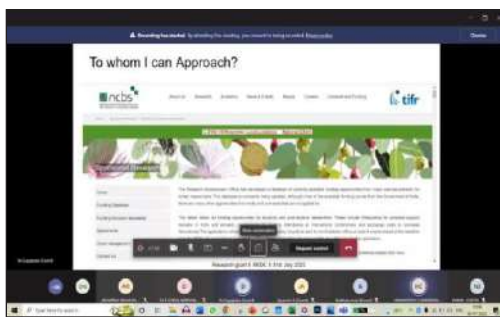


National educational policy- Quality enhancement & reforms in Higher education institutions

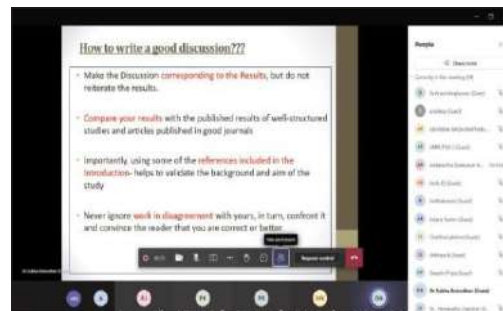
Mental Health Awareness And Stress Management

Training On E-Content Development

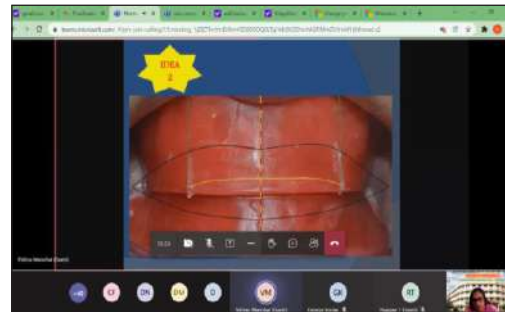
